Hello families!

This year we will be using Seesaw! Seesaw is a fun and engaging virtual learning tool for your young learner and you, their caregivers!

Seesaw has two apps - Seesaw CLASS and Seesaw FAMILY. Seesaw CLASS is for the students to complete activities the teacher assigns and add to their journal on their own! You'll log on to CLASS with a text code your teacher provides you that is for your specific child. Seesaw FAMILY is meant for you, the adults, to see your students work and communicate with their teacher. We will still be using the FAMILY account to communicate with the adults. You'll continue to log on to FAMILY using your personal email and password.

What is Clever?


Clever is a "portal" where you can access many apps used by your student's school or classroom teacher(s). Visit www.bostonpublicschools.org/backpack to access Clever.

- sign in with a Clever Badge




Option 1: Use your BPS Gmail and password.

- 1. Go to www.clever.com/in/bostonpublic.
- 2. Press the "Log in with Google" button. You should login with your BPS Gmail and password.

Option 2: Sign in with a Clever Badge.

On a BPS-managed Chromebook

Turn on the Chromebook and click "Next" at the login screen to be presented with the camera window. If students want to login with their Gmail account, they should click "Sign in with a different account" instead.




On Mac and Windows Devices


